She had filed on a homestead east of the Ike Roger's place on Upper Middle Prong of Wild Horse Creek. They both filed on and proved up on their homesteads.

George Chester, Jr. was born on August 22, 1927 at Sheridan, Wyoming. In August of 1930 they moved to Sheridan permanently and Chester started to work at Fort McKenzie.

Shirley Ann was born to them August 15, 1932 and Oren Menagh on January 23, 1938.

In 1951, Chester retired on a disability from Fort Mc-Kenzie and a year later underwent back surgery. His health improved somewhat and he invested in Rawleigh Products which he sold over Sheridan County for twenty years, or more. Chester sold their home a few years ago and moved into Sheridan, to retire.
